| Q2 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment modifying the date on which the terms of Councilmembers commence. | Pass | 76.6% |
| Q3 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment modifying the date on which the Mayor and Councilmembers are inducted into office. | Pass | 77.1% |
| Q4 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment clarifying the vacancy period calculation for the Mayor and Councilmembers. | Pass | 76.6% |
| Q5 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment eliminating requirement that City Clerk appointment by the City Manager be subject to Council approval. | Pass | 51.9% |
| Q6 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment eliminating requirement that City Treasurer appointment by the City Manager be subject to Council approval. | Fail | 48.5% |
| Q7 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment authorizing the City Attorney to call executive sessions with the Council, for purposes permitted by law. | Pass | 69.1% |
| Q8 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment changing the criteria regarding 24-hour reading/posting prior to introduction of ordinances and resolutions. Specifically, the change permits suspension of the 24-hour requirement by 3/4 of the Council, in-lieu of requiring the unanimous consent of all Councilmembers present. | Fail | 49.5% |
| Q9 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment modifying the criteria for passage of emergency measures by the Council. Specifically, the change recognizes passage by 3/4 of the Council, in-lieu of requiring approval by five members. | Pass | 74.8% |
| Q10 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment modifying publication requirements of ordinances and resolutions to provided consistency with State law. | Pass | 78.0% |
| Q11 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment establishing a process to allow the sale of real property, by the City Manager with Council approval, within two years following a solicitation for the sale that resulted in no bids being submitted. | Pass | 67.5% |
| Q12 | Flagstaff | 5/19/15 | Charter amendment modifying the period in which nominating petitions are to be presented to the City Clerk. The change is from 60 to 90 days prior to the primary election, to 90 to 120 days prior to the election. | Pass | 75.2% |

| 405 | Yuma | 3/10/15 | Reverts zoning on specified property to Limited Commercial/Aesthetic Overlay in lieu of Conditional High Density Residential, as requested by property owner to facilitate development of Wal-Mart Neighborhood Market. | Pass | 76.5% |
| 406 | Yuma | 3/10/15 | Changes land use designation of specified property to Mixed Use in lieu of High Density Residential, as requested by property owner to facilitate development of Wal-Mart Neighborhood Market. | Pass | 75.1% |
