
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Bud loves to play with friends at a video game cafe.

In the box below, draw your dream job.




**Bud asks Tito more about his job. Tito's job is to manage the front counter at the game cafe. Bud likes the idea of running a game cafe.**





# ACTIVITY

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












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## ACTIVITY






## ACTIVITY




**After a lot of hard work, Bud grows the business enough to pay back the bank loan. Bud uses extra money in the business plan to throw a party for all the friends who helped!**

Starting a business and becoming an entrepreneur is just the beginning for Bud. Can you help Bud find his way back to the bank to pay back the loan?



# VOCABULARY SHEET

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


## **BANK:**

A business where customers can borrow money, make deposits, and earn interest for saving.

## **BUSINESS:**

A company that sells products or performs services to make money.



## **EARNINGS:**


Is when you are given money for work or chores.

## **EMPLOYEE:**

A person who works for a business.

## **ENTREPRENEUR:**

A person who owns their own business.



## **JOB:**

A task someone does for a business to earn money.


## **LOAN:**

Money a person or business can borrow from a bank that needs to be paid back in a specified time frame.

## **PROFIT (LOSS):**

The income of a business minus its expenses.

A positive number is profit, and a negative number is a loss.



## **SALARY:**

The amount of money an employee is paid for doing their job.


