Official Rules

- 1. Each Entrant must be a student who is enrolled at a public school, public charter school, parochial school, or home school.
- 2. Eligibility limited to students in these 14 states: Alabama, California, Colorado, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Michigan, Missouri, New Mexico, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Texas, and Utah.
- 3. Entrants must be on track to graduate in 2025. Essays and personal statements must be e-mailed or postmarked by **Friday, April 11, 2025**. Students may submit only one entry.
- 4. Entrants are encouraged to submit their common app essay and a 150-word personal statement that addresses the importance of education, obtaining a college degree, and goals for post-college. Each entrant must write the essay and personal statement themselves and in their own words.
- 5. Common App essay topics include:
 - Some students have a background, identity, interest, or talent that is so meaningful they believe their application would be incomplete without it. If this sounds like you, then please share your story.
 - The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
 - Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?
 - Reflect on something that someone has done for you that has made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you?
 - Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.
 - Describe a topic, idea, or concept you find so engaging that it makes you lose all track of time. Why does it captivate you? What or who do you turn to when you want to learn more?
 - Share an essay on any topic of your choice. It can be one you've already written, one that responds to a different prompt, or one of your own design.
- 6. Stifel, Nicolaus & Company, Incorporated ("The Firm") will establish a panel of judges who will look for writing that is clear, articulate, and well organized. Essays will be judged on both style and content. Decisions made by the panel are final.
- 7. If entrant is selected as a winner, additional information will be requested. The winning entrant will be notified via e-mail by June 30 and will receive a one-time \$2,000 scholarship presented by The Firm on or before the end of summer of 2025.

8. Immediate family members of elected or appointed officials or employees of The Firm are not eligible for this contest.

- 9. All essays must be accompanied by:
 - Cover sheet including the entrant's name, address, phone number, e-mail address, high school, and the name of a parent or guardian.
 - Registration form including:
 - Statement signed by the entrant that the essay submitted is the original work of the entrant.
 - Statement signed by the parent or guardian indicating that the parent or guardian approves of the entrant's participation in the scholarship essay contest.
 - Statement by a school official confirming that the entrant is a student in good standing, on track to graduate from the 12th grade in 2025.
 - Release form signed by the student, parent or guardian, and person(s) named or identified in essay.
- 10. **E-Mail Submissions:** Essays should be submitted as a single-spaced Microsoft Word document. E-mail your essay and accompanying forms to: fabricofsociety@stifel.com.

Mail Submissions: Essays sent by U.S. mail or delivery service must be typewritten double-spaced. Include a word count with the essay.
